
Welcome to Year 6

We hope you've had an enjoyable summer holiday and feel excited for the academic year ahead. Each term, we send you a letter to share with you what your child will be learning about in each subject. Next term, Year 6 will begin their 'Local Fieldwork' area of study, with particular links to Geography. The children will learn to describe and understand key aspects of both physical and human geography and conduct fieldwork in the local area.

In **Geography**, we'll be learning to:

- Recall our knowledge from Year 5 to be able to name and describe the world's climate zones
- Understand why Geographers conduct fieldwork
- Use a variety of different tools to access fieldwork
- Developing enquiry questions about our local environment
- Complete fieldwork and analyse the data we collect to answer our enquiry questions
- Create our own sketch maps of a local area





In English, the children's writing will be based on the genre of 'Modern Fiction,' where they will read the wonderful text 'Wonder,' by R.J. Pallacio. In their Whole Class Reading sessions, the children will be reading 'The Nowhere Emporium,' by Ross Mackenzie.

When in Maths, the children will be investigating numbers up to ten million and will apply their knowledge to order and compare large numbers. Additionally, the children will be recapping their understanding of Place Value from Year 5.



Finally, in Science, the children will be building on their prior learning of classifying plants and animals, by exploring and understanding 'Living Things and their Habitats'.
