What another brilliant term in Nursery we have had, where we were able to build and consolidate our knowledge throughout all areas of learning. We were able to enjoy a farmyard theme day to finish off our area of study 'On the Farm'. We have all had a positive attitude towards our learning this term and have really impressed the adults. We hope you have a wonderful half-term break and look forward to you joining us again on Monday 19th February, for the first day of Term 4.

Next term, 'Build Me a Home, will be our area of study. The children will be exploring different types of homes and what the differences between them are. We will also compare our own houses to the homes and habitats of animals. As part of our area of study, we will begin to learn parts of our address and describing what our house looks like.


Our key nursery rhyme next term will be 'Humpty Dumpty'. Additionally, we will have three core stories that we will focus on throughout the term. These will be, 'I'm Big Now', 'The Three Little Pigs', and 'Tip, Tip, Dig, Dig'. These exciting stories link to our area of study, 'Build Me a Home'.
