
Year 4 – Term 5 – Curriculum Letter

We have had another fantastic term in Year 4, where we have been able to build and develop our key knowledge across the curriculum. We have celebrated many whole school events such as World Book Day, Red Nose Day, and our Annual Easter Senior Citizen event which were enjoyable for all. In addition to this, we have also been thrilled to receive a visit from Cornwall Climate Care and participated in their 'Climate Change and Fresh Water Systems' workshop. We hope you have a wonderful Easter break and look forward to you joining us again on Monday 15th April for the first day of Term 5.

Throughout Term 4, we learnt about 'Ancient Egypt' in History, explored 'Sound' in Science, and developed our 'painting' skills in Art. Next term, Year 4 will begin their 'Ancient Egypt (Part 2)' learning in History where the children will learn about the significant pharaohs of Ancient Egypt. The children will build upon their previous knowledge from Ancient Egypt (Part 1) and begin to understand how the pharaohs changed the civilisation.

In **History**, we'll be learning to:

- Increase our range of vocabulary relating to the passing of time (chronological understanding).
- Place some historical periods in a chronological framework.
- Research significant figures such as Akhenaten, Ramessess II and Ptolemy II.



In English, the children's writing will be based on the genre of persuasive writing and 'Myths and Legends', where they will build their understanding through a series of core texts. In their Whole Class Reading sessions, the children will be studying 'How To Train Your Dragon' in 4PP and 'Secrets of a Sun King' in 4KJ.

Then, in Math's, the children will continue in their learning on fractions before moving onto building their understanding of decimals. Finally, in Science, the children will be exploring living things and their habitats. This will allow them to build on their knowledge from Key Stage One.


