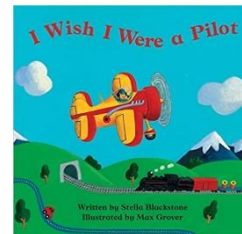
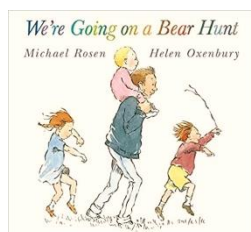
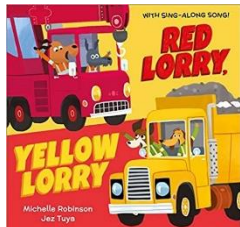
## Pre School – Term 6 – Curriculum Letter

As we come to the close of another term, we are delighted with the children’s commitment to enhancing their attitudes towards learning and have yet again been incredibly fortunate to see many children heading out on exciting trips and visits. Notably, our Bee Keeping club proudly showcased their skills at the Devon County Show, while our very own Mr. Meredith had the honor of representing us at the prestigious King’s Garden Party. As we celebrate these achievements and bid farewell to another term, we extend our gratitude to you all for your continued support and look forward to what Term 6 has to offer.

Next term, Pre-School will begin their ‘**Let’s GO!**’ area of study. This provides the children with the opportunity to build on their understanding of where they live and how we can travel around our community and city. This will be a wonderful topic for children to explore their own surroundings, and what different vehicles we can use to explore them.



Our core books next term are below and our Key Nursery Rhymes will be ‘**Humpty Dumpty Sat on a Wall**’ and ‘**The Wheels on the Bus**’.

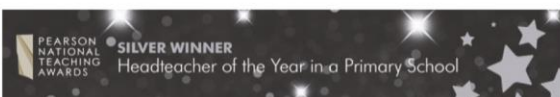


In **Phonics**, the children will be revisiting, and building upon, the phonic knowledge they gathered in the last year. The children will continue to develop their blending of sounds in order to start identifying words. As a class the children will continue to print letters from their names and use this letter knowledge to ‘write’ by making purposeful marks and letter-like formations.

In **Maths**, the children will continue to revisit and build upon their knowledge of Number (0-5) and numeral

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formation. They shall also be developing their understanding of number bonds to five, subitising objects and using this knowledge to solving problems in their play.

## Learning at Home

In Pre-school, we encourage you and your child to **share a book as often as you can**. Your child’s joy for reading is always learned best when celebrated at home. Please **check Tapestry weekly** to see your child’s Home Learning for the week and the re-cap of what we have covered in school. We look forward to seeing the learning you share with us from home.

**PE** next term will still be on a **Friday morning**. Lots of the sessions will take place outdoors so please ensure your child has an appropriate PE kit and a water bottle. As the days become warmer, a hat and sun cream are also advised

As the days start to get hotter and sunnier, please remember to send your child into school with a hat and a short-sleeved T-Shirt. On hotter days we also ask that your child come into school with sun cream applied prior to their session start. Please make sure you have completed the MS Consent form that was shared with you.
